

STUDENTS WILL BE READING 3 BOOKS THEY HAVE NEVER READ BEFORE FOR THIS INDEPENDENT READING PROJECT. 1 BOOK WILL BE DUE DURING EACH OF THE EVEN MARKING PERIODS (2^{ND} , 4^{TH} , and 6^{TH}). STUDENTS WILL CHOOSE RANDOMLY AND PROJECTS WILL BE TURNED IN ON EITHER THE 1^{ST} OR 2^{ND} HALF OF THE MARKING PERIOD.

THE PROJECTS ARE EACH WORTH 40 POINTS. HOW IT WORKS:

CHOOSE A BOOK FROM THE GENRE CHOICES. YOU MAY NOT CHOOSE THAT GENRE AGAIN.

ONCE YOU HAVE COMPLETED READING THE BOOK, YOU WILL COMPLETE A PROJECT FROM THE PROJECT CHOICES LIST. YOU MAY ONLY USE A PROJECT CHOICE ONCE.

YOU <u>MUST</u> HAVE YOUR PARENTS APPROVAL ON YOUR BOOK CHOICE AND SIGN OFF THAT YOU HAVE NEVER READ THAT BOOK BEFORE.

STUDENTS MAY USE ACADEMIC PREP CLASSES AND/OR STUDY HALLS AS THEIR INDEPENDENT READING PROJECT TIME, EITHER TO READ OR WORK ON THE PROJECT.

PROJECTS CAN BE TURNED IN AT ANY TIME DURING THE MARKING PERIOD BUT MUST BE SUBMITTED BY THE ASSIGNED DAY FOR CREDIT.
